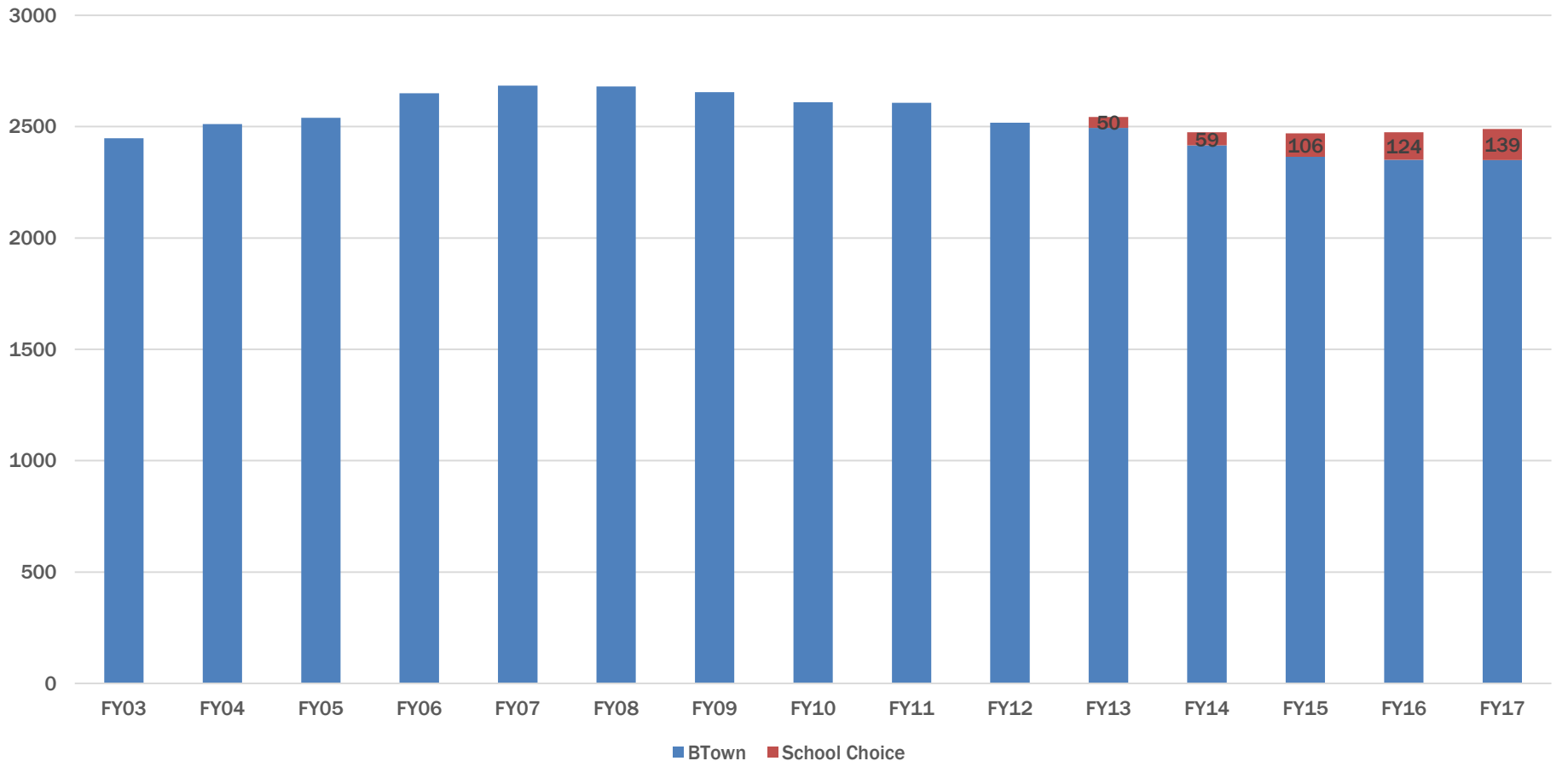

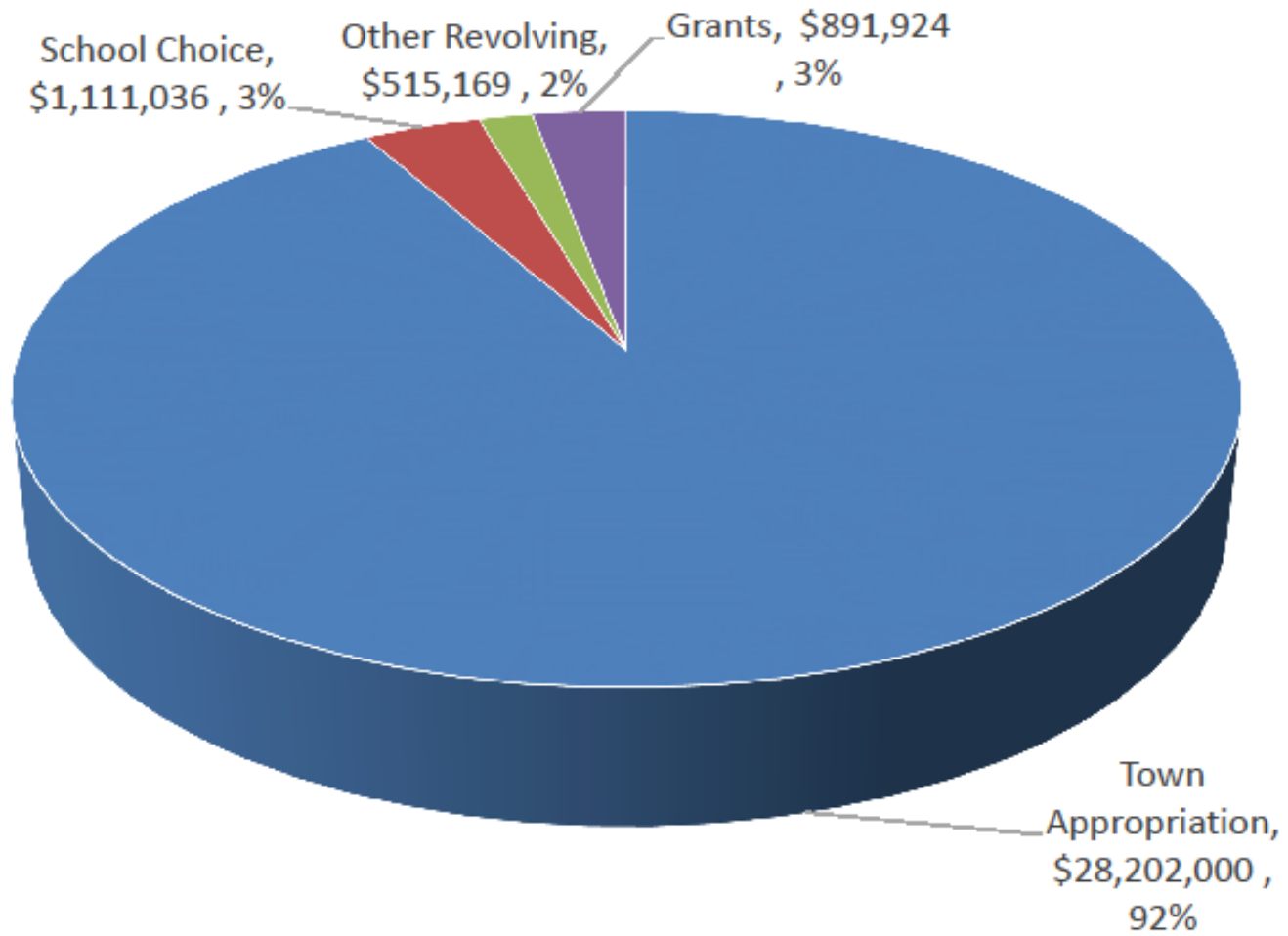

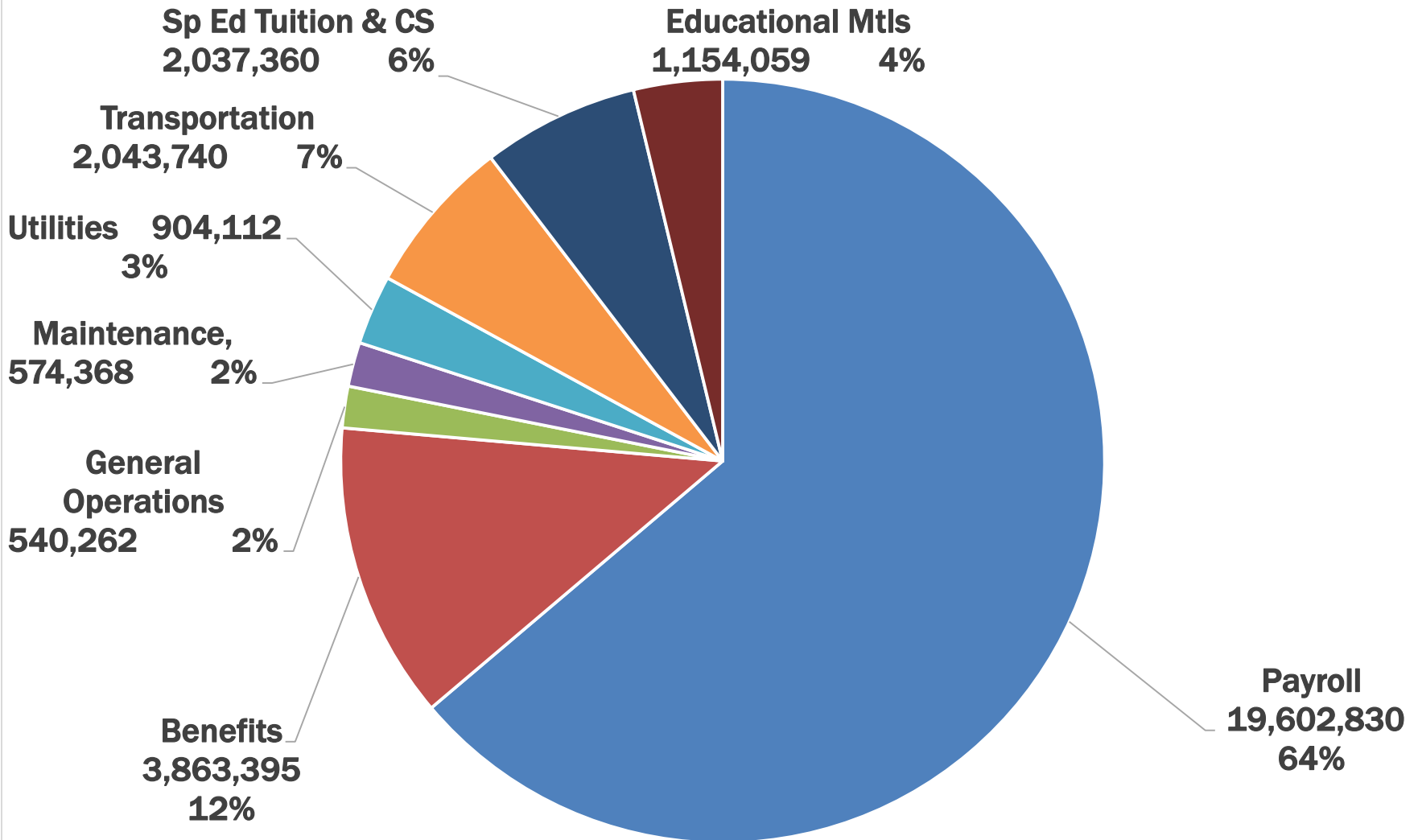

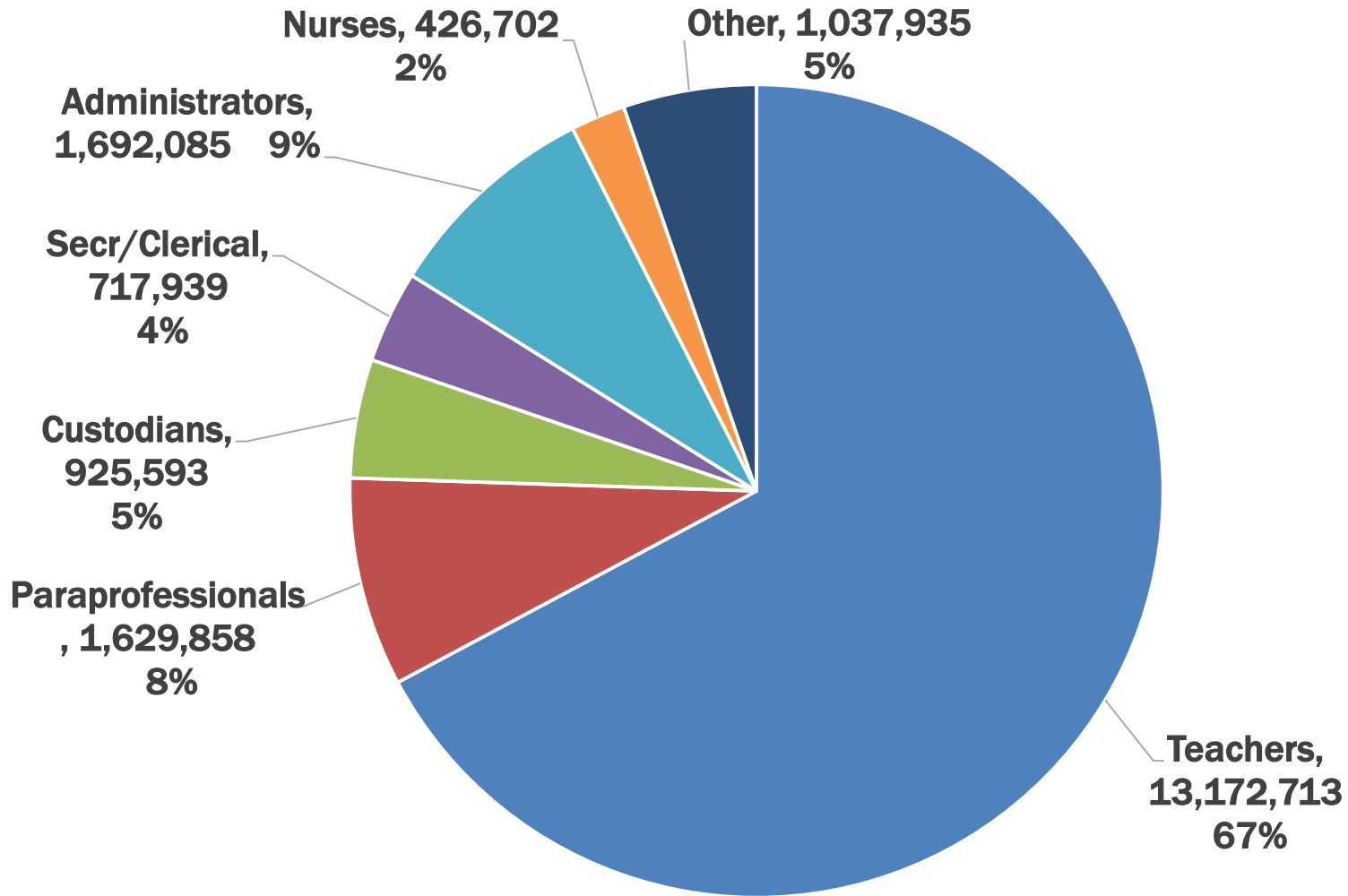

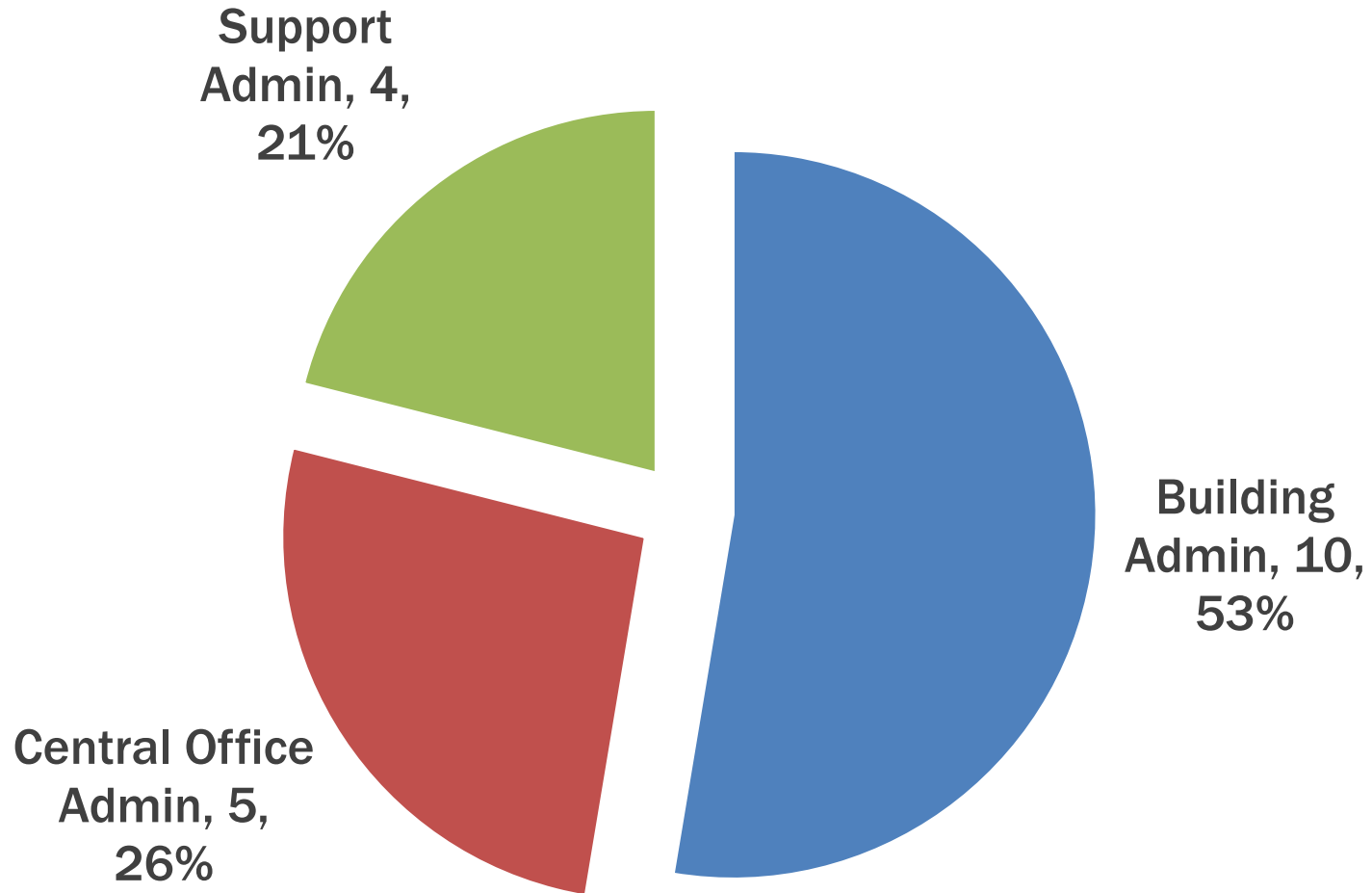


FY18 PAYROLL
